

Vessel Specification – 2004 Crownline 270 CR

Descriptions

This sports cruiser has lots of family appeal and presents in immaculate condition.

This 270 CR features:

- Balanced performance,
- Good helm position and
- Large outdoor seating areas
- Shelter from the elements Large V Berth and also mid/aft cabin
- This boat is very much in the family category and with a top speed around 30 knots

The 320hp 6.2lt MPI MerCruiser delivers an efficient cruise speed around 22 knots and a top speed of over 30 knots.

This Crownline 270 CR also features:

- High topsides and high bow for a smooth, mostly dry ride in all most conditions.
- Also responds very well to trim/tilt

The engine itself is surprisingly quiet, with excellent insulation.

The seat is adjustable and the dash is well appointed with various instruments.

Layout

- A large swim platform with swim ladder
- Toilet with fresh water shower
- Plenty of Stowage areas are well located on the boat.

The walkway from the swim platform gives step over or step through access to the generous comfort zones.

Standard stainless steel bimini top and storm clears offers protected days and nights out.

The cockpit offers seating for eight adults. The wet bar has freshwater, a small garbage/stowage area, and several drink holders.

There is also a removable table, sunlounge, removable carpets, full camper covers and V berth to show just how versatile this 27 footer actually is.

The cabin has ample natural light via the hatch and two side portholes.

The forward area has plenty of headroom plus a large storage pocket port and starboard for all your safety gear.

The Bow:

- Access is through the windscreen using a step.

- The bow area has low bow rails that offer some good security points.
- The anchor well is also very adequate and this vessel has a stainless steel anchor on board

Electronic features include a Clarion CD player with remote control at the helm and 12 volt saloon lighting.

The helm is very well set up with instruments including fuel, volts, speed, revs, temp, depth, trim gauge and an accessory outlet.

The engine is accessed with an electronic hydraulic lift that raises the aft seat for easy access to the engine room.

The Crownline 270 CR offers good performance and a range of creature comforts that will keep the whole family happy.

This Crownline 270 CR is powered by MerCruiser 320hp MPI with a Bravo One leg. There are five batteries and the engine room is insulated, providing a smooth and quiet ride.
